### IMPORTANT!! MESA PALMS PROJECTS

Mesa Palms Church is actively fundraising to pay for a number of upgrades and projects that are urgently needed. Your donations are making a difference already and are so appreciated! Here's the list:

> Mesa Palms Projects Costs as of June 2024

- 1. \$16,777 Facility Security—alarm system & cameras
- 2. \$46–56,000 Audio/Visual \$21,000 Equipment \$25–35,000 Labor
- 3. \$16,000 Window inserts in 25 interior doors at \$625 (one quote available so far)
- 4. \$5,000 Storage shed on site
- 5. \$30,000 Lot lighting completion on south section of property
- 6. \$30,000 Parking lot—crack fill, repairs, reseal and restripe (\$225–234,000 for complete repaying)

TOTAL: \$144-154,000

### UNION-DESIGNATED OFFERING CALL Next Step Scholarships October 12, 2024

The Pacific Union believes that students are best served in Adventist education. However, the decision to actually place a student in an Adventist school is often impacted by the cost of tuition. Too often parents feel unable to afford Adventist education and another option is selected. To help encourage parents to take Next Step, the Pacific Union created the Next Step Scholarships to help provide assistance at key enrollment points:

Entering kindergarten

- Leaving 8th grade and moving into 9th grade

— Or choosing an Adventist college or university. To help make the decision easier, the seven conferences in the Pacific Union now have access to several scholarships of up to \$750 for kindergarten, up to \$2,500 for 9th grade, and \$2,000 for freshman at both La Sierra University and Pacific Union College.

One parent shared, "The Next Step Scholarship made the difference in enabling my child to attend an Adventist academy. We couldn't have done it without help." I invite you to help support this special scholarship program. This offering will go directly to provide additional scholarships so that more students can receive the financial help needed at these important decision points. Students that start in our schools usually stay in our schools, but if they leave, or never start, the student misses out on the blessing of an Adventist education.
