# CURRENT NEEDS FOR OUR WOMEN'S MINISTRY OUTREACH PROJECTS

CAAFA July, August, and September: Household and Basic Goods. General purpose cleaning supplies (urgent need); Clorox/Lysol wipes (urgent need); paper towels (urgent need); mop and broom; pots and pans (urgent need); manual can openers (urgent need); paper, plastic, or glass dishes; silverware and cooking utensils, and more.
